Application Guide for General and Senior Visiting Students Programs

• Submit an online application

Log on to Peking University's online application portal (http://www.studyatpku.com) and apply online. Once you log into the portal, click on "Online Application", choose "Non-Degree Programs Application" and choose "Chinese Government Scholarship Candidates (General Senior Visiting Students Program/Senior Visiting Students Program)". Enter your application details and upload the relevant documents, submit the application, print the application form (not webpage) downloaded upon successful submission and attach a passport-sized photograph on the space provided.

- Submit the following paper application documents by post:
 - 1. Peking University Online Application Form for International Students (with passport-sized photo attached).
 - Certification of highest degree attained or Certificate of Enrollment at University, original documents or certified copies, either in Chinese or English:

Applicants for the **General Visiting Students program (Chinese language studies/Undergraduate course studies)** should provide certification of highest degree attained (Bachelor/Master/PhD) or Certificate of Enrollment at university.

Applicants for the **Senior Visiting Students program** should provide certificate of graduation in Master's degree program or certificate of enrollment in Ph.D. degree program.

3. Official academic transcripts, original documents or certified copies, either in Chinese or English:

Applicants for the **General Visiting Students program (Chinese language studies/Undergraduate course studies)** should provide transcripts of Bachelor's degree.

Applicants for the **Senior Visiting Students** program should provide transcripts of Master's degree or Ph.D. degree.

- 4. Statement of Purpose (no less than 1000 words in Chinese/English).
- 5. TWO letters of recommendation written either in English or Chinese by your professor or associate professor (or by lecturers with equivalent academic standing).
- 6. Photocopy of your current valid passport (ID page) (passport type must be ordinary).
- 7. Proof of Chinese language proficiency:

Applicants for **Chinese language studies under the General Visiting Students program** can provide proof of Chinese language proficiency (if any);

Applicants for undergraduate course studies under the General Visiting

Students program should provide HSK Level 6 certificate (with a score of above 180);

Applicants for the **Senior Visiting Students program** can provide proof of Chinese language proficiency (if any).

- 8. Acceptance letter (paper or e-mail) by Peking University professors, or nomination letter by Peking University's partner universities for student exchange (if any).
- 9. Abstracts of published academic works (if any).

NOTE: - Items 8 and 9 are optional. Submitted documents will not be returned.

• Other **IMPORTANT** notes:

- 1. Exchange students will be preferentially admitted if they are already nominated as per the student exchange agreement by Peking University's partner universities for the academic year 2018-2019.
- 2. Applicants who have already submitted their applications as year 2018 exchange students can dispense with resubmitting items 2 and 3.
