Application Guide for Master's and Ph.D. Degree Programs

Submit an online application

Log on to Peking University's online application portal (http://www.studyatpku.com) and apply online. Once you log into the portal, click on "Online Application", choose "Degree Programs Application" and choose "Chinese Government Scholarship Candidates (Master's or Ph.D. Program)". Enter your application details and upload the relevant documents, submit the application, print the application form (not the webpage) upon successful submission and attach a passport-sized photograph on the space provided.

- Submit the following paper application documents by post:
 - 1. Peking University Online Application Form for International Students (Master and Ph.D. Programs) (with passport-sized photo attached).
 - 2. Graduation certificate and degree diploma (Students expecting to graduate should provide an official letter stating expected graduation date), must be original documents or certified copies either in Chinese or English. Applicants for a Master's degree should provide Bachelor's degree graduation certificate. Applicants for a Ph.D. degree should provide both Bachelor's and Master's degree graduation certificates.
 - 3. Official transcripts of your academic achievement up to the present, including courses taken and standard achieved, must be original documents or certified copies either in Chinese or English.
 Applicants for a Master's degree should submit a Bachelor's degree transcript. Applicants for a Ph.D. degree should submit transcripts of both Bachelor's and Master's degrees.
 - 4. Statement of Purpose (no less than 1000 words in Chinese or English).
 - 5. TWO confidential Letters of Recommendation written either in Chinese or English by your professor or associate professor (or by lecturers with equivalent academic standing), each letter in a separate, sealed envelope, endorsed (signed) across the seal (Letter of Recommendation can be posted directly to Peking University International Students Division by the recommender). The letters should be particularly addressed to Peking University and explicitly evaluate the applicant's eligibility to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship. The softcopy of the letters should be e-mailed directly to csc@pku.edu.cn by the recommenders.
 - 6. Photocopy of the ID page of valid passport (passport type must be ordinary).
 - 7. Proof of Chinese language proficiency (HSK results). If you have not taken the HSK exam, please state your Chinese language proficiency and number of years learning Chinese.
 - 8. Acceptance letter (paper or e-mail) by Peking University professors (if any).
 - 9. Abstracts of published academic works (if any).

NOTE: Please submit TWO copies (except for the letters of recommendation) of

the above application materials (one original and one photocopy). Items 7, 8 and 9 are optional. Submitted documents will not be returned.

Other IMPORTANT notes:

- 1. Students who do not meet the expected language proficiency for Chinese-taught programs may be scheduled to attend language preparatory courses for 1-2 years.
- 2. Applicants who have already submitted their applications as 2018 self-funded students can dispense with resubmitting items 2, 3, 6, 7, 8 and 9. Please indicate the application number of the previous application on the printed Online Application Form.
