

Application Guide for Bachelor's Degree Programs

- Submit an online application:

Log on to Peking University's online application portal (<http://www.studyatpku.com>) and apply online. Once you log into the portal, click on "Online Application", choose "Degree Programs Application" and choose "**Chinese Government Scholarship Candidates (Undergraduate Program)**". Enter your application details and upload the relevant documents, submit the application, print the application form (not the webpage) downloaded upon successful submission and attach a passport-sized photograph on the space provided.

- Submit the following paper application documents by post:

1. Peking University Online Application Form for International Students (with passport-sized photo attached).
2. Senior high school graduation diploma (Students expecting to graduate should provide an official letter stating expected graduation date, and submit the graduation diploma if admitted), which should be original documents or certified copies in Chinese or English.
3. Official transcripts of your academic achievements up to the present, including courses taken and grades achieved (original documents or certified copies in Chinese or English).
4. Statement of Purpose (no less than 1000 words in Chinese or English).
5. ONE confidential Letter of Recommendation written either in English or Chinese by your senior high school teacher in a sealed envelope, endorsed (signed) across the seal (Letter of Recommendation can be posted directly to Peking University International Students Division by the recommender). **The letter should be particularly addressed to Peking University and explicitly evaluate the applicant's eligibility to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship. The softcopy of the letter should be e-mailed directly to csc@pku.edu.cn by the recommender.**
6. Proof of admission to other universities (if any).
7. One photocopy of ID page of valid passport (passport type must be ordinary).
8. Proof of Chinese language proficiency (HSK results). If you have not taken the HSK exam, please state your Chinese language proficiency and number of years learning Chinese.

NOTE: Please submit original copies for items 1, 2 and 3. Submitted documents will not be returned.

- Other **IMPORTANT** notes:

1. All Bachelor's degree programs in Peking University are taught in Chinese. Students who do not meet the expected language proficiency may be

scheduled to attend a pre-university program for 1-2 years.

2. Applicants who have already submitted their applications as 2018 self-funded students can dispense with resubmitting items 2, 3, 7 and 8. Please indicate the application number of the previous application on the printed Online Application Form.
